Purpose of Filing:

The purpose of this filing is to comply with the above Order which directed the Company to revise its tariff to comply with the requirements of PSL §66-j which revised the megawatt (MW) threshold from 1 MW to 2 MW for net energy metering of farm waste electric generating equipment. Ordering Clause 2 of this order also directed the Company to file an updated Standardized Interconnection Requirements (“SIR”) as an addendum to the tariff as discussed in the Order. These revisions were directed to be filed on not less than two days’ notice to become effective on December 1, 2016.

Attachment 1 included with this filing contains redlined leaves to show where these changes have occurred.

The newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law § 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR 720.8 for these revisions has also been waived by this Order.
