Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing amendments to its tariff in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order to implement changes necessary to effectuate the modifications to the commodity provider switching process.

Overview

In accordance with the Order, Energy Service Companies ("ESCOs") may submit an enrollment by submitting the request 10 business days prior to the effective date of the switch for a natural gas customer. The Companies have also made revisions to its Gas Transportation Operating Procedures ("GTOP") Manual to reflect the changes in enrollment switching process. The GTOP Manual has been posted on the Companies' Gas Tracking System ("GTS") website for 30-day review. At the end of the 30-day review period, the Companies will submit the final version of the GTOP Manual.

Publication

The Companies respectfully request the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication be waived as this change will not affect the majority of the Companies' customers.
