Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing Statement RDM-8 to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – GAS ("Gas Tariff"). This statement is issued November 20, 2015, to become effective December 1, 2015.

The purpose of this filing is to implement the reconciliation of the Company's gas revenue decoupling mechanism for the period November 1, 2014 through October 31, 2015 ("Rate Year 6") in accordance with General Information Section No. 25, Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Adjustment, of the Gas Tariff.

The Rate Year 6 cumulative net delivery revenue over-collections for Group A and Group B¹ are \$228,749 and \$705,684, respectively, including interest.

Group-specific RDM adjustments have been determined to refund this excess net delivery revenue over the twelve-month period commencing December 1, 2015.

¹ Group A consists of Service Classification No. 1 and Service Classification No. 6 Rate Schedule IA customers. Group B consists of Service Classification No. 2 and Service Classification No. 6 Rate Schedule IB and Rate Schedule II customers. For the three month period ended October 31, 2015, the Company has included in Group B's RDM calculation approximately 1,800 customers that were moved to a Group A rate structure in August 2015.
