Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E") (the "Company") hereby submits for filing the enclosed **revised** tariff statements, effective **December 1, 2015**, in compliance with the New York Public Service Commission's ("Commission's") <u>Order Regarding Retail Renewable Portfolio</u> <u>Standard ("RPS")</u>, issued and effective September 24, 2004 in Case 03-E-0188, (the "2004 Order") and <u>Order Authorizing Customer-Sited Tier Program Through 2015 and Resolving Geographic</u> <u>Balance and Other Issues Pertaining to the RPS Program</u>, issued and effective April 2, 2010 in Case 03-E-0188, (the "2010 Order").

RPS Statement No. 15 to PSC 18 – Electricity RPS Statement No. 15 to PSC 19 – Electricity

The tariff statements are being filed to implement a correction to the rates filed on October 1, 2015. The rates filed on October 1 inadvertently included an estimate of under/over collections through September 2014 instead of September 2015. The RPS calculation oversight was discussed with Department of Public Service Staff and the Company was advised to re-file the rate. The revised RPS rate updates the estimate of under/over collections through September 2015.

To calculate the December 2015 RPS rate, the incremental under-collection of \$615,372 was divided by the kWh sales estimate for the period December 2015 – September 2016, resulting in an incremental increase of \$0.000102 per kWh to the currently effective rate. When this amount is

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added to the current rate of \$0.002334 per kWh, the revised effective rate in December will be \$.002436 per kWh.

The surcharge amount is reflected in the attached tariff statements.

Per Ordering Clause 6 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12) (b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by this filing is waived.
