The enclosed leaf issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“Company”) is being transmitted for filing in compliance with the Commission’s Order issued April 10, 2015 and November 25, 2015 in the above case number (the “Order”).

To PSC No. 220 Electricity

Effective: December 14, 2015

On December 7, 2015 the Company issued its filing in accordance with the above order to revise Service Classification No. 7 – Standby Service to incorporate the CHP exemption as directed in the Exemption Expansion Order. The above leaf was inadvertently omitted from that filing and contains tariff language that was relocated to the above leaf due to the CHP exemption language on the previously filed leaf in this case.

Ordering Clause 2 of the Exemption Expansion Order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments that were included.

Also, per this order this leaf will become effective on one day’s notice in accordance with the above orders.
