In accordance with the Order Establishing Rate Plan, issued and effective September 21, 2010 in the above-referenced cases, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E") hereby file the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Statements to be effective November 1, 2015.

RDM Statement No. 6 to PSC 16 Gas RDM Statement No. 6 to PSC 19 Electric RDM Statement No. 9 to PSC 87 Gas RDM Statement No. 10 to PSC 88 Gas RDM Statement No. 5 to PSC 120 Electric

The filing of service classification or sub-classification specific RDM surcharge/credit rates is in accordance with the Companies' filed tariffs and Appendix U of the Rate Plan<sup>1</sup>. NYSEG and RG&E will file the annual service classification or sub-classification specific RDM surcharge/credit rates with the Commission, on not less than 30 days notice, to be effective November 1st of each year.
