Dear Commissioners:

Pursuant to Public Service Commission Order, issued and effective June 17, 2015, in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files additional amended tariff leaves and statements to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 12 – Gas. The purpose of the following amendments which are filed August 14, 2015 to become effective August 15, 2015 on a temporary basis is described below.

The purpose of this filing is to revise the NYSA surcharge applicable to gas Service Classification No. 11 ("SC 11") customers. The aforementioned Order effectuated a volumetric SC 11 rate design and acknowledged that the change would require conforming structural changes to other charges such as the NYSA. Gas NYSA-10 which was filed in the Company's initial Compliance filing made on June 29, 2015 inadvertently failed to reflect this conforming change. The Company hereby files a corrected statement as well as modifications to tariff language to reflect the same. Language modifications have also been made to the form of transportation service agreement for SC 11 and the Excelsior Jobs Program as it relates to SC 11.

The Company requests a waiver of newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) (b) for this filing, as the Company has already complied with Ordering paragraph six by publishing notices of the change in the July 8, 15, 22 and 29, 2015 issues of the Catskill Daily Mail, the Daily Freeman, the Times Herald Record, the Putnam County Courier and the Poughkeepsie Journal.
