## **Purpose of Filing:**

On February 22, 2016 the Company submitted a compliance filing conforming their tariffs in accordance with Chapter 495 of the Laws of 2015 which amended Public Service Law to add a new Section 70-a. Section 70-a established procedures for the transfer of ownership of complete street lighting systems to municipalities or other government entities.
