Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an amendment to the Company’s Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. The Tariff leaf, which is identified below, has an effective date of September 21, 2016.

Reason for Filing

The Commission, in its Order Accepting Modified Reliability Contingency Plan (the “Order”), issued and effective September 15, 2016, in Case 12-E-0503, directed that the Company file tariff amendments, as needed, to effectuate its Order modifying the 125 MW Energy Efficiency/Demand Reduction/Combined Heat and Power (“CHP”) Program.

The Company recovers the 125 MW Energy Efficiency/Demand Reduction/CHP Program costs through its Monthly Adjustment Clause (“MAC”) component 37, pursuant to the Commission’s Order in Case 12-E-0503, issued November 4, 2013. The Company is revising MAC component 37 to indicate that this recovery is also based on the Commission’s Order of September 15, 2016.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 5 of the Order, this tariff amendment is being filed on not less than 14 days' notice, to become effective September 21, 2016, on not less than one day's notice.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 6, the Commission has waived newspaper publication of the tariff change.
