#### Dear Secretary Burgess:

The enclosed revised Statements, issued by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") are transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of the New York Public Service Commission's (the "Commission") Order Authorizing System Benefits Charge Collections, issued and effective on August 3, 2016 (the "Order"), in the above referenced proceedings. The Statements will become effective on September 1, 2016.

SBC Statement No. 13 to P.S.C. No. 87 – Gas SBC Statement No. 15 to P.S.C. No. 88 – Gas

#### Purpose of Filing

NYSEG is filing updated tariff Statements pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order to collect an additional \$1,651,000 over a 28-month period through the System Benefits Charge ("SBC") on gas distribution customers.

NYSEG will increase its SBC (NYSERDA Energy Efficiency) surcharge from \$0.007327<sup>1</sup> to \$0.00868 per therm. The incremental rate of \$0.001353 per therm was calculated by dividing the amount authorized by forecasted units for the 28 month period ending December 2018. The rate will be in effect from September 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

The SBC surcharges will be reset on January 1, 2017 incorporating the Commission's authorized collections, any prior period reconciliations, and the collection of the 2017 portion of the \$1.6 million.
