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Purpose of the Filing

The enclosed revisions to the Company's Schedule P.S.C. No. 1 - Water, are designed to produce an annual increase in base rates of \$18.4 million (14.1%) for the proposed New York District and \$14.1 million (16.8%) for the proposed Westchester District. The Company's proposed rates will increase the approximate average residential monthly water bill by \$0.19 per day in Rockland and Orange County, \$0.38 per day in the City of Rye, and the villages of Rye Brook and Port Chester in Westchester County; \$0.20 per day in Heritage Hills, and \$0.51 per day in Owego. Customers in other parts of Westchester will see an increase of \$0.39 per day.

The increases are primarily driven by capital investments needed to ensure the Company can continue to deliver safe, adequate and reliable water service. The Company has invested approximately \$328 million over the past three years and is planning on spending an additional \$473 million over a four-year period starting with the new rate plan. The Company has also seen cost increases in chemicals, energy, purchased water and increased treatment costs relating to current and upcoming water quality regulations, as well as costs and lost revenues resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Prepared written testimony and exhibits comprising VWN's direct case in support of these tariff revisions are being filed with the Commission contemporaneously under separate cover.
