Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Electric Tariff leaf, identified below, is filed to become effective on November 1, 2022:

**Reason for Filing**

This filing is pursuant to the Commission’s *Order Clarifying Procedure for Implementing Clean Heat Program*, issued on October 13, 2022, in Case 18-M-0084 (the “Order”), in response to the Company’s petition filed on February 24, 2022, in Case 18-M-0084 (the “Petition”). The Petition sought recovery for incremental costs related to the Company’s Clean Heat Program. The Order approved the recovery of said costs and directed the Company to file tariff amendments to effectuate the cost recovery mechanism.

### **Tariff Changes**

Pursuant to the Order, the Company added a new component to the Monthly Adjustment Clause (“MAC”) in the Electric Tariff to recover costs related to the Continuity Funding Mechanism for the Company’s Clean Heat Program, amortized over a 10-year period.

### **Conclusion and Notice**

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing this tariff change on no less than one day’s notice, to become effective on November 1, 2022. As specified in Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
