In accordance with the Order Adopting Energy Affordability Policy Modifications and Directing Utility Filings (issued and effective August 12, 2021) in Cases 14-M-0565 and 20-M-0266 (the "Order"), KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid hereby files the following formula-based tariff updates to the Energy Affordability Program ("EAP") credits:

Statement of Energy Affordability Credit No. 6 ("EAC")

To PSC No. 1 Gas

Effective: December 1, 2022

This filing complies with Ordering Paragraph 20 of the Order, which directed the Company to file annual modifications to its EAP tariff statement as well as associated workpapers. In this case, the formula would result in an EAP credit reduction for KEDLI Gas customers. Given forecast commodity prices and economic considerations, the Company will be evaluating the underlying factors affecting this year's credit calculation and, based on those findings, consider options to adjust EAP benefits.
