Statements GSC-261 and FTR-290, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 6, 11, 12 and 13 will become effective on October 3, 2022. Statement FTR-290 includes the Weighted Average Cost of Capacity and the WBS Weighted Average Cost of Storage. Statements IGR-291 and ITR-284, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 8 and 9, will also become effective on October 3, 2022.

Pursuant to Order in Case 17-G-0460 dated June 14, 2018, a new Gas Miscellaneous Charge mechanism was implemented to address the recovery and refund of new initiatives including interruptible refunds or surcharges applicable to Service Classification No. 11 customers, Gas Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("RAM") and Earnings Adjustment Mechanism ("EAM") incentives.

Appendix 7-H related to GSC-261 has been filed with trade secret status directly with the records access officer. Appendix 7-H and Exhibit I related to GSC-261 have also been sent directly to the Commission's Staff.
