Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with the *Order Authorizing Phase I Arrears Reduction Program* (issued and effective June 16, 2022) in Cases 14-M-0565, 20-M-0266, and 20-M-0479 (the “Order”), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (the “Company”) submits for filing the gas tariff leaves on Attachment A. Specifically, this Order directed the Company to file, on not less than five days’ notice, tariff amendments necessary to effectuate the Electric and Gas Bill Relief Program and Arrears Management Program Recovery Surcharge (“AMP”), to take effect, on a temporary basis, on July 1, 2022.

Ordering Clause No. 12 of the Order waives Public Service Law §66 (12) (b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 regarding the requirement of newspaper publication for these revisions. The Company will provide notice to the public of the tariff changes once a week for four consecutive weeks in general circulation newspapers in the areas affected by the changes and file with Commission proof of the notices.
