In accordance with the Joint Proposal approved by the Public Service Commission in an Order dated August 12, 2021 in the above-captioned matter (the “Order”), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (“KEDNY”) submits its Statement of Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Surcharge / Surcredit (“RDM”) in compliance with Rule 50 of the Company’s tariff, PSC No. 12 – Gas. Since the RDM rate is one of the components included in the Statement of Delivery Rate Adjustment (“DRA”), the DRA statement will be filed once all July 1st rate statements have been submitted.
