In accordance with the Joint Proposal approved by the Public Service Commission in an Order dated August 12, 2021 in the above-captioned matter (the “Order”), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (“KEDNY”) submits its Statement of Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Surcharge / Surcredit (“RDM”) in compliance with Rule 50 of the Company’s tariff, PSC No. 12 – Gas. Since the RDM rate is one of the components included in the Statement of Delivery Rate Adjustment (“DRA”), the DRA statement will be filed once all July 1<sup>st</sup> rate statements have been submitted.
