In compliance with the Commission's Orders in Cases 20-E-0543 and 19-E-0566 issued and effective April 14, 2022, ("Order 1"), and Case 21-E-0536 issued and effective April 14, 2022, ("Order 2"), Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the addendum listed below to become effective May 1, 2022 on not less than five days' notice.

Addendum SIR No. 29 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements

This filing is being made in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of Order 1 and Ordering Clause No. 1 of Order 2 which instructed the Company to make any necessary tariff amendments to update the Standard Interconnection Requirements (SIR) addenda in conformance with Appendix B of Order 1 and the Appendix of Order 2.

Updates to the SIR which were adopted by the Commission include: the implementation of new cost-sharing rules governing distributed generators and energy storage systems sized 5 MW or less; addressing the information available as part of utilities' hosting capacity maps; and provisions for reimbursing developers for project interconnection upgrade costs.

As directed per Ordering Clause No. 8 of Order 1 and Ordering Clause No. 2 of Order 2, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication have been waived.
