In accordance with General Information Section 35 of P.S.C. No. 15 - Electricity, the Statement listed below is filed to become effective April 1, 2022.

P.S.C. No. 15 - ELECTRICITY

Statement of Accounts Receivable Discount

DISC - 20

The purpose of this filing is to update the accounts receivable discount factor applicable to Central Hudson's ("the Company's") purchase of an ESCO/retail supplier's customer billings where Central Hudson is providing consolidated billing service to the ESCO/retail supplier. The factor consists of a two-part rate equivalent to the Company's most recent actual three-year average of net write-offs plus 0.05 percent to reflect other costs of the program. Discount Statement No. 20, to become effective April 1, 2022, reflects a discount rate of 0.79 percent, comprised of the Company's actual three-year average net write-offs of .74 percent for 2019 through 2021, plus 0.05 percent to reflect other costs of the program.
