Re: Annual System Benefits Charge ("SBC") Filing

Dear Secretary Phillips,

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") herein submits for filing its Statement of System Benefits Charge, Statement No. SBC – 12 to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY. This Statement is issued December 17, 2021, to become effective with service rendered on or after January 1, 2022.

This filing is in accordance with General Information Section 26 of the Company's Schedule for Electric Service requiring an annual SBC filing in accordance with the Commission's January 21, 2016 Order in Case 14-M-0094 et al. ("January 2016 Order") and the Commission's February 11, 2021 Order in Case 20-M-0082 ("February 2021 Order").

The proposed SBC rate is based on: (1) an SBC Clean Energy Fund ("CEF") collection target of \$20,479,730 as contained in the January 2016 Order for the period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022;¹ and (2) an Integrated Energy Data Resource ("IEDR") target of \$405,863.² The determination of the proposed SBC rate also includes the reconciliation of SBC recoveries for the period January through December 2021. The amount over-collected for the reconciliation period is \$11,868. The resulting SBC rate is 0.552 cents per kWh for the CEF portion and 0.011 cents per kWh for the IEDR portion, equating to a total SBC rate of 0.563 cents per kWh.

¹ The Company's Statement of SBC also collects the previously-authorized Renewable Portfolio Standard, Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard, and SBC IV amounts.

² As outlined in the February 2021 Order, IEDR costs were allocated in proportion to the total electric load for 2019 among the New York Power Authority, the Long Island Power Authority, and jurisdictional utilities. The \$405,863 represents the Company's share of the \$13,500,000 IEDR costs as billed by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority.
