**RE: Rider AB - Smart Home Rate**

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”) applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. The revised Tariff Leaves, which are identified below, are filed to become effective on March 1, 2022:

**Tariff Changes Proposed**

The Company is proposing changes to Rider AB – Smart Home Rate to conform to the changes described in the Company and Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc.’s. Implementation Plan Update for its active Reforming the Energy Vision – Demonstration Project: Smart Home Rate<sup>1</sup>, dated October 22, 2021, in Case 14-M-0101 (the “Revised Implementation Plan”).

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<sup>1</sup> The Company is also filing on a separate cover similar changes to the Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY.

The Company proposes the following changes to the Electric Tariff: (1) eliminate Rider AB Rate II, and all references related to it; (2) remove the battery storage offering and all references related to it; and (3) modify Rider AB Rate I to conclude on March 31, 2023. In addition, the Company is clarifying that the SHR will conclude as of the Customer's last billing cycle when their participation in the SHR has ended.

### **Conclusion and Notice**

The Company is filing changes to the Electric Tariff to become effective on March 1, 2022. The Company will provide public notice of the tariff changes in this filing by means of newspaper publication once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to the effective date of the proposed tariff changes. Included is a proposed form of Notice of Proposed Rule Making for publication in the State Register pursuant to the State Administrative Procedures Act.
