RE: Rider J – Smart Home Rate

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY (the “Electric Tariff”).

The revised Electric Tariff leaves, which are identified below, are filed to become effective on March 1, 2022.

Tariff Changes Proposed

The Company is proposing changes to Rider J – Smart Home Rate to conform to the changes described in the Company and Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.’s Implementation Plan Update for its active Reforming the Energy Vision – Demonstration Project: Smart Home Rate¹, dated October 22, 2021, in Case 14-M-0101 (the “Revised Implementation Plan”).

The Company proposes the following changes to the Electric Tariff: (1) eliminate Rider J Rate II, and all references related to it; (2) remove the battery storage offering and all references related to it; and (3) modify Rider J Rate I to conclude on March 31, 2023. In addition, the Company is clarifying that the SHR will conclude as of the customer’s last billing cycle when their participation in the SHR has ended.

¹ The Company is also filing in a separate cover similar changes to the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity.

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Conclusion and Notice

The Company is filing changes to the Electric Tariff to become effective on March 1, 2022. The Company will provide public notice of the tariff changes in this filing by means of newspaper publication once a week for four consecutive weeks prior to the effective date of the proposed tariff changes. Included is a proposed form of Notice of Proposed Rule Making for publication in the State Register pursuant to the State Administrative Procedures Act.
