Attached for filing electronically with the Commission are the following tariff leaves, issued by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company"), to become effective on October 1, 2000. These leaves are issued in compliance with Commission Order in Case 00-G-0996, issued and effective August 24, 2000.

The purpose of this filing is to make further revisions to the tariffs that we issued on August 30, 2000 in Case 00-G-0996. As directed by the Public Service Commission Staff, Central Hudson has made the following revisions to our August 30, 2000 filing:

(1) We have replaced all reference to "penalties" with "charges";

(2) reworded the tariffs to make it clear that both human needs customers and customers using distillate fuel are required to meet the reserve supply requirement;

(3) reduced the time allowance from 24 hours to 4 hours, for customers having difficulty meeting the requirements of a curtailment, before curtailment charges are assessed;

(4) noted that the customer's reserve inventory must be in place on or before November 1;

(5) instituted a \$2.50 per Ccf charge for noncompliance of a curtailment and a separate charge based on the market price of the customer's alternate fuel for noncompliance of the reserve requirement; and,

(6) included the provisions in our Service Classification No. 14 tariff.

As directed in Ordering paragraphs 1 and 2, the requirements of 66((12)b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication has been waived.
