#### **Reasons for Proposed Revisions**

On March 31, 1997, NYSEG submitted a "housekeeping" filing to its P.S.C. No. 88 Gas tariff. The filing was necessary in order to incorporate into NYSEG's electronic tariff P.S.C. No. 88. which superseded P.S.C. No. 83, a revised Addendum to P.S.C. No. 83 and update the Service Agreement for Repackaged Gas Services. The Company's update to the Service Agreement for Repackaged Gas Services was to incorporate changes that were made to the Agreement since its inception and to add "Exhibit A" to the Agreement. Staff has reviewed this filing and has recommended further revisions.

### **Proposed Revisions**

These proposed revisions, which have been recommended by Staff, are to clarify the language in the Agreement.

#### **Customer Impact Assessment**

These revisions will have no impact on NYSEG's gas customers.

### **Newspaper Publication & SAPA**
