Enclosed for filing with the Public Service Commission ("the Commission ") is a revised schedule leaf issued by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or "the Company") to reflect revisions to the Company's Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 - Gas, as identified below:

P.S.C. No. 9 - Gas

Third Revised Leaf No. 393.0
Superseding Second Revised Leaf No. 393.0

The tariff leaf is issued November 4, 1999 to become effective November 5, 1999 and bears a notation that the leaf is issued in compliance with the subject case number.

Reasons for Tariff Changes

On September 30, 1999, the Company filed changes to its gas tariff in compliance with the Commission's September 22, 1999

order (Case No. 98-M-1343). In that filing, among other things, the Company had stated that the Marketer would be responsible for updating the evidence that it meets the Company's credit requirements without specifying what those requirements are.

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Staff had suggested that the requirements be clearly defined. The change proposed herein provides a clarification of those requirements. Today's filing is being made electronically.
