The above revisions are issued as of the date hereof for an effective date of October 1, 2000. The Company requests that the tariff leaves become effective on "short notice" in order to go into effect simultaneously with tariff leaves originally filed on September 1, 2000.

On September 1, 2000, the Company submitted a filing in response to the Commission's Order dated August 24, 2000 in Case 00-G-0996. Upon consultation with Staff for the Department of Public Service, the Company has determined to refine the language of the September 1 filing by adding the following:

"For Customers that utilize distillate fuel oil as their alternate fuel source or are human needs Customers," . . .

The purpose of this further modification is to narrow the application of the subject provisions to distillate fuel oil and human needs customers.
