Reasons for Proposed Revisions

On April 21, 1995, NYSEG submitted a filing to the Public Service Commission revising its electric and gas tariffs to expand the definition of the monthly billing period from 27 to 33 days to 25 to 35 days (Case No. 95-G-0420). The revision was made to P.S.C. No. 30 - Gas, however, the revision did not get made to P.S.C. 84 - Gas (now PSC No. 89).

This error just came to our attention, therefore, the Company is submitting a "housekeeping" filing to revise PSC No. 89 Gas to bring the tariff up-to-date.

Customer Impact Assessment

The expanded billing period has been applied to all of NYSEG's customers since it was approved by the Commission in its October 18, 1995 order, therefore, this revision is "housekeeping" in nature and there will be no customer impact.

Newspaper Publication & SAPA

NYSEG requests waiver of publication of this proposed change in accordance with 16 NYCRR Part 270.70, as this "housekeeping" revision has NO direct impact to NYSEG's gas customers.
