The Company has experienced a significant undercollection of approximately \$8 million in its Gas Supply Charge ("GSC") for the period September 1, 2002 through February 28, 2003. The Company estimates that this undercollection will decline somewhat by August 31, 2003, the end of the annual GSC period, but a significant undercollection will remain that would be collected through a reconciliation adjustment commencing January 1, 2004. To minimize this undercollection, the Company has implemented an adjustment of 3 cents/ccf, commencing April 1, 2003. This adjustment is reflected on Statement GSC-29.
