Reasons for Proposed Revisions

Housekeeping filing to remove incorrect wording in the Minimum Charge section of Service Classification No. 3 of PSC No. 87 Gas to clarify the statement.

Proposed Revisions

On March 7, 1997, the PSC approved NYSEG's new electronic tariff, PSC No. 87 Gas, which superseded P.S.C. Nos. 73, 75, 76, 79, 82 and 86. Further review by Staff revealed incorrect wording in the Minimum Charge section of Service Classification No. 3. The words "reduced by" are being removed from the sentence of paragraph 2 to clarify the intent of the statement.

Customer Impact Assessment

Since these revisions are "housekeeping" in nature, there will be no customer impact.
