Proposed Revisions

The above leaf is being filed in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Commission's April 13, 1998 order in the above-referenced case.

Background

On December 8, 1997, NYSEG filed Schedule No. 90 to supersede Schedule No. 30 (Case No. 97-G-2085). Schedule No. 90 is the electronic version of Schedule No. 30 and was allowed to become effective on February 27, 1998. Subsequently, on January 23, 1998, NYSEG filed amendments to its gas tariffs to revise the charge for incremental service line installations from \$4.50 per foot to \$5.00 per foot.

Purpose of the Filing

In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Commission's April 13, 1998 order in Case No. 98-G-0100, NYSEG proposes to update the new Schedule No. 90 with the new incremental service line installation charge to make the tariff current and up-to-date.
