These statements reflect the unbundled rate structure to become effective on December 1 in accordance with the Commission's Opinion and Order Adopting Terms of Settlement, issued and effective November 20, 2000, in Case No. 99-G-1695. The GAC statement and FTR (SC 6) statement have been eliminated. New statements for the Gas Supply Charge and Monthly Gas Adjustment have been added. The unbundling of rates also affects the interruptible, dual fuel and NGV statements since they rely in part on firm rates.
