The purpose of this filing is to comply with the Commission's Order on March 24, 1999 to file further tariff revisions resulting from the Commission's Policy Statement of November 3, 1998.

These revisions include tariff language that complies with the Commission's order on sharing of capacity release revenues, uniform formula for the capacity cost calculation and using "Transition Surcharge" as the title of this mechanism.

These tariff leaves and statement are being made effective on one day's notice as permitted by the order; waiver of the requirement for prior newspaper publication was granted.
