The enclosed revised and original leaves, issued by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG" or the "Company"), are transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission (the "Commission" or the "PSC"), State of New York.

Effective June 11, 2002.

In compliance with the Commission's <u>Order Concerning ESCO Deposits and Prepayments</u>, issued May 9, 2002 (the "May 9th Order") in the above proceeding, the Company has modified its gas tariff provisions for Marketer Creditworthiness.

The May 9th Order contains the Commission's latest changes to UBP creditworthiness rules. It establishes credit requirements to permit a Marketer to accept prepayments and deposits from customers. With the proposed changes filed today, a Marketer that has submitted certain bond rating evidence, posted a letter of credit, or created an escrow account with a financial institution with at least an A credit rating, may accept prepayments and deposits from its customers. According to the May 9th Order, Marketer policies pertaining to deposits and prepayments must be set forth in Marketer disclosure statements and shared with PSC Staff prior to implementation.

On June 7, 2002, NYSEG electronically submitted and overnight mailed a Petition for Rehearing of the May 9th Order in conjunction with Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation. NYSEG will file revisions to the enclosed tariff leaves if that Petition is approved by the PSC.
