The purpose of this filing is to make further revisions to the monthly balancing provisions under Service Classification No.9 - Interruptible Transportation Service that were proposed by the Company in its June 7, 2000 filing.

As per our conversation with PSC staff, the Company is changing its original proposal and will flow through to the firm customers 100% of the revenues collected when the monthly balancing penalty is imposed on a Retail Supplier. In addition, a typographical error on leaf 175.1 has been corrected.

The Company requests approval of these changes on short notice to allow the tariffs to become effective on September 1, 2000.
