Reasons for Proposed Revisions

This filing is being submitted to make “housekeeping” revisions to NYSEG’s electric tariffs.

Proposed Revisions

NYSEG is proposing to make the following tariff leaf revisions:

PSC 119:

Leaf Nos. 52, 54 61 and 81 of PSC 119 – Correct references to PSC 115 by replacing them with the currently effective Schedule: PSC 120.

PSC 120:

Leaf No. 60 of PSC 120 – Add Service Classification (SC) 11 to the list of SC’s eligible for retail access.

Leaf Nos. 133, 134, 160, 162, 220 and 222 of PSC 120 –Clarify the reference to SC 11 by specifying Special Provision (d) of SC 11.

Leaf No. 272 of PSC 120 - Correct the late payment charge from “1 2%” to “1 ½ %”, consistent with the text description of that percentage.

PSC 121:

Leaf No. 2 of PSC 121 – Add the title of Section 17, Renewable Portfolio Standard, to the Table of Contents.

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Leaf No. 22 (SC 1) of PSC 121– Mark this leaf as “Reserved for Future Use” because the contents were reorganized and placed on leaves 19 and 20 when Street Lighting rates and tariffs were unbundled on tariff leaves that became effective Feb. 1, 2006, pursuant to the PSC’s Order issued December 23, 2005 in Cases 05-E-0876 and 05-G-0878.

Leaf Nos. 33 & 34 (SC 2) of PSC 121– Mark these leaves as “Reserved for Future Use” because the contents were reorganized and placed on leaves 30 and 31 when Street Lighting rates and tariffs were unbundled on tariff leaves that became effective Feb. 1, 2006.

Leaf No. 36: Delete the number of the paragraph (3) and insert a phrase to clarify that these Other Facilities Charges are associated with all rate choices within SC 2 (the phrase will make SC 2 consistent with existing language in SC 3).

Leaf Nos. 52, 53 & 54 (SC 3) of PSC 121 – Mark these leaves as “Reserved for Future Use” because the contents were reorganized and placed on leaves 45 through 48 when Street Lighting rates and tariffs were unbundled on tariff leaves that became effective Feb. 1, 2006.

Leaf No. 58: Delete the number of the paragraph (3) and delete the underlining of the section title “Other Facilities Charges”.

Newspaper Publication and SAPA

NYSEG requests waiver of publication of these proposed changes in accordance with Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1, as these “housekeeping” revisions have no direct impact on NYSEG’s electric customers.
