Purpose of the Filing

The Company is filing revisions to its tariff in compliance with the December Order. RG&E was authorized to continue the Incremental Load Rate (ILR) incentive program, which provides a discount on the delivery portion of a customer's bill, for an additional four-year period until December 31, 2012. The tariff revisions herein provide for the four-year extension period. A clarification has also been added within the General Information Section 4, Metering and Billing. The additional language clarifies that eligibility for billing on the ILR rate incentive is based on kW (and kWh) usage.

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In addition to the changes made in accordance with the December Order, RG&E has been instructed by Staff to include in this filing three additional leaves that require a housekeeping change to correct revision numbering. The three leaves were listed as part of the Economic Development Plan filed on September 2, 2008, and now require revision updates.
