National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation to establish a set of commercially
reasonable standards for door-to-door sales of natural gas to ESOPs.

Dear Secretary Brillling:

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) submits
the following amendment to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 - GAS:

Supplement No. 36

The proposed revision is issued as of today for an effective date of October 30, 2008.
The Company requests that the Supplement be given “short notice” in order to go into effect
simultaneously with the tariff leaf suspended until October 30, 2008.

Distribution submitted a tariff amendment proposing to add a section to its customer
aggregation tariff, Service Classification No. 19, Supplier Transportation, Balancing and
Aggregation, requiring energy service companies doing business in Distribution’s service
territory to comply with a set of commercially reasonable standards for door-to-door sales of
natural gas. The sole purpose of this filing is to cancel the proposed tariff amendment effective
October 30, 2008 to comply with Clause No. 8 in the Commission’s *Order Adopting
Amendments to the Uniform Business Practices, Granting in Part Petition on Behalf of
Customers and Rejecting National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation’s Tariff Filing* issued and
effective October 27, 2008.

Distribution requests that the Commission accept the instant filing for a “short notice”
effective date of October 30, 2008, as directed by the Commission.
