Pursuant to discussions with Commission Staff, the Company has filed an interim surcharge of 3.715 cents per Ccf to begin recovery of an estimated gas cost under-collection of \$2,195,630 related to the twelve months ending August 31, 2007, the current GSC reconciliation period. The purpose of the interim surcharge is to reconcile gas costs on a more current basis so as to minimize the possibility of a large under-collection at the end of the reconciliation period. The interim surcharge will be effective during the period February 1, 2007 to August 31, 2007.
