This filing is also made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H).

In accordance with Ordering Clause 1 of the May 23 Order, RG&E has made revisions to the above mentioned tariff leaves to provide for a three-year extension of the May 31, 2006 generation project inservice deadline. The new generation project in-service deadline for qualifying for an exemption from standby rates or a phase-in to those rates is May 31, 2009.

In accordance with Ordering Clause 2, the requirement of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by the tariff amendments required in Ordering Clause 1 is waived.
