The enclosed tariff leaves, issued by Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or "the Company") are transmitted for filing in further compliance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") Order Adopting Gas Curtailment Guidelines and Requirements issued and effective August 23, 2007 (the "Order"). The tariff leaves are transmitted for filing in compliance as identified herein and in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H). The leaves are proposed to become effective on one day notice, on a temporary basis pending Commission approval.

Purpose and Details of the Filing

Based on conversations with the Department of Public Service Staff ("Staff"), the Company is filing further revisions to tariff leaves that were filed on October 30, 2007 to become effective on November 1, 2007. Tariff Leaf No. 69 was revised to include language that the Company will recover compensation for diverted gas through the Monthly Gas Supply Charge. Modifications were made to Leaf 127.19.1 to update the name of the Office of Electric, Gas and Water of the New York Public Service Commission. Additionally, Leaf 127.19 was modified to include the specific market price of gas under the penalty and compensation section of the tariff.. Finally, Leaf 70 was updated to reflect additions made to Leaf 69 that changed the numbering on Leaf 70.
