Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") hereby submits for filing the following tariff leaves proposing revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS (the "Gas Tariff") in compliance with the Commission's "Order Adopting Gas Curtailment Guidelines and Requirements" (the "Order"), issued and effective August 23, 2007, in Case 06-G-0059:

Summary of Tariff Modifications

Pursuant to ordering clauses 1 and 3 of the Order, the foregoing tariff leaves being filed electronically today, are effective November 1, 2007, on a temporary basis. The Order directs the Company to file tariff amendments to its Gas Tariff consistent with the "Gas Curtailment Guidelines" ("Guidelines") attached as Appendix B to the Order. The Guidelines set forth the criteria local distribution companies ("LDC") are to follow to meet the gas requirements of their highest priority human needs customers during periods of gas shortage or when there are problems on a LDC's distribution system. To implement such Guidelines, the Company has made revisions to (1) General Information

Section III.14 "Gas Service Curtailments", (2) General Information Section VII "Gas Cost Factor and Monthly Rate Adjustment", and (3) General Information Section IX "Special Adjustments" of its Gas Tariff.

The Company will make applicable changes to its Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual ("GTOP") upon Commission approval of the tariff changes on a permanent basis.

Notices

Pursuant to ordering clause 4 of the Order, the requirements of Public Service Law § 66 (12) (B) as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by the tariff amendments filed today are waived.

Pursuant to ordering clause 2 of the Order, copies of this filing are being served today on all Parties to this proceeding.
