Reasons for Proposed Revisions

This filing is being submitted to make "housekeeping" revisions to RG&E's gas tariffs.

Proposed Revisions

RG&E had filed tariff amendments to update its DG rates for commercial and industrial customers, S.C. Nos. 6 and 7, to reflect their new rates for non-DG customers in compliance with the Commission's <u>Order Providing for Distributed Generation Gas Service Classifications</u>, issued April 24, 2003 in Case 02-M-0515 ("DG Order"). The purpose of this filing is to consolidate changes that were made in compliance with the DG Order with changes that were filed by the Company on May 4, 2007 to establish an Advanced Metering Infrastructure Surcharge ("AMI Surcharge").

Due to the timing of these filings and their effective dates, tariff revisions for establishing the AMI Surcharge did not contain the rates that were filed in compliance with the DG Order.

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The proposed revisions herein reflect the consolidation of these filings to ensure that the correct rate that was filed in compliance with the DG Order continues to stay effective, and sets forth the AMI Surcharge that the Company has proposed.

Newspaper Publication and SAPA

RG&E requests waiver of publication of these proposed changes in accordance with Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1, as these "housekeeping" revisions have no direct impact on RG&E's gas customers.
