Dear Secretary Brilling:

Attached for filing with the Commission is First Revised Tariff Leaves 2, 26, 27 and 28 to the Schedule for Electric Service P.S.C. No. 2 ELECTRICITY issued by Massena Electric Department ("Massena" or "the Company") to become effective January 1, 2006.

The purpose of this filing is to update reconnection charges to more accurately reflect the costs to Massena to perform these services. These charges have not been increased since 1990. In addition, Massena would like to charge customers a fee for checks received as payment and subsequently dishonored by the bank. This fee will cover Massena's administrative costs for handling such checks. The proposed tariff leaves will not result in a material gain in revenues for the Company. Rather, they will better cover the costs associated with the services provided. A workpaper is attached detailing the method used to calculate the cost of reconnection services.
