In compliance with the Commission's Order Modifying and Approving Tariffs and Providing for Further Proceedings, Cases 02-E-1282 and 05-E-0697, issued September 26, 2005 (the "Order"), NYSEG hereby files revised tariff leaves to address concerns specified in the Order.

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Description of Tariff Revisions

In accordance with the Order, the Company is removing all tariff language relative to the inaccuracies of single meters running in reverse, as applicable to new net metering installations.

Furthermore, the Company is modifying its tariff to provide for the annual reconciliation to be computed at the avoided cost of energy for the most recent twelve-month period for all customers, not just for customers with generators sized at or greater than 10 kilowatts.

Also, NYSEG is filing a revised Standard Interconnection Requirements ("SIR") Addendum to reflect revisions to the SIRs as outlined in the Order.

Finally, NYSEG is amending its tariff to address, on an interim basis, the process to credit excess generation produced at a residential customer's location where the customer has installed Solar generation and Wind generation ("Hybrid Facility"). A customer that installs a Hybrid Facility will be responsible for interconnection and transformer charges as identified in Section I.A.Step 6.4.d of the SIR Addendum.

Technical Conferences

In accordance with ordering paragraph four, the Company will participate in all technical conferences to be conducted by Department of Public Service Staff to resolve issues relative to the installations of Hybrid Facilities.

Newspaper Publication

In accordance with ordering paragraph three, the requirement of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication is waived.
