The purpose of this filing is to revise the filing issued to the Commission on December 20, 2002 with a postponed effective date of June 27, 2005 in the above case. The original filing proposed revisions to PSC No. 214 to more clearly define the netting of bills related to municipal street lighting accounts. The revisions were made to facilitate the requirements of street lighting proceedings in Case Nos. 99-E-0387, 00-E-0934 and 00-E-0935 which required the Company to be more accurate in street lighting billings.

After further discussions between Staff of the Public Service Commission and Staff of Niagara Mohawk it was decided that further revisions would be required to the original filing. The above leaves include these agreed upon revisions.

Waiver of short notice is requested for these leaves to become effective June 27, 2005 to be coincident with the leaves presently before the Commission in Case No. 02-E-1645.
