Effective January 1, 2004.

The above-listed leaves are being filed pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order Providing Clarifications And Denying Petition For Rehearing</u>, in Case No. 02-E-1282, issued March 20, 2003. That Order directed that utilities examine their tariffs and submit any tariff amendments necessary to specify use of the revised Standardized Interconnection Requirements standard contract.

On April 28, 2003, NYSEG filed extensive tariff changes regarding the Farm Waste program and the Standard Interconnection Requirements ("SIRs") in compliance with another Order that was issued on March 20, 2003, specifically the <u>Order Modifying Net Metering Tariffs and Establishing Standard Interconnection Requirements</u>, Case No. 02-E-1654. In the April 28, 2003 filing, NYSEG modified its tariffs for the Farm Waste program and conformed its tariffs to utilize the new SIR contract and standards specified in that Order.

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However, subsequent to that filing, NYSEG identified additional tariff changes that were inadvertently overlooked in the April 28, 2003 compliance filing. NYSEG is filing tariff modifications today to make additional conforming changes to correct its references to the SIR contract and Interconnection requirements. The revisions affect PSC 120 – Electricity tariff provisions for Residential Solar Electric Service and its PSC 119 – Electricity tariff for revised SIRs.
