Statement of Gas Appliance Repair No. 2

To PSC No. 219 Gas

Effective: February 1, 2004

The Company is filing the above tariff leaves and statement as a housekeeping filing to correct minor errors contained on the sixteen above-mentioned tariff leaves and statement.

First Revised Leaf No. 2, and First Revised Leaves No. 61 through 69, correct the heading name of Section 13 from "Interim Estimated Billing" to "Meter Reading." Section 13.1 on Leaf No. 61 has been revised to contain the "Interim Estimated Billing" heading.

First Revised Leaf No. 97, Paragraph 17.8.1, removes the reference to Monthly Balancing as Operational Flow Orders are only applicable to Daily Balancing.

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First Revised Leaves No. 131 and 132 have been revised to correct the misspelling of the word "Supply" in the heading.

Second Revised Leaf No. 184, Paragraph 3A, revises the wording in the sentence "The term of each such release will be for one year and one day" to "The term of each such release will be determined by the Company." This revision is a result of changes in Federal regulations.

First Revised Leaf No. 196, Section 6C, has been revised to change "12 prices" to "99 prices" and the word "plan" to "option." It also changes the wording "without being prorated" to "and will be prorated." First Revised Leaf No. 197, Section 6D, also revises the wording "will not be prorated" to "will be prorated." These changes are being made to reflect current practice by the Company.

Lastly, the Statement of Gas Appliance Repair No. 2 has been revised to remove the heading "Per Therm," as this charge is per occurrence, not per therm.

The Company requests waiver of newspaper publication of the proposed changes required by 16 NYCRR 720-8.1 as the changes filed herein have no significant impact on the Company's customers.
