the July Order, and the tariff leaf attached to this filing letter, individually negotiated contracts
pursuant to either paragraph 22 or 23 of the Joint Proposal can become effective on or after
August 11, 2003.

In accordance with the Order, newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments has
been waived.
