The enclosed revised tariff leaves, issued by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") are transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission").

<u>PSC No. 88 – Gas, Schedule for Gas Service</u> Leaf No. 50.27, Revision 2 Addendum – UBP No. 2

<u>PSC No. 120 – Electricity, Schedule for Electric Service</u> Leaf No. 109, Revision 2 Addendum - UBP No. 2

Effective August 16, 2004.

The above tariff leaves are being filed pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order on Petitions</u> for Rehearing and Clarification, issued July 15, 2004 (the "Order") and the Errata Notice issued August 2, 2004 (the "Errata Notice") in the above-referenced proceeding.

According to the Order, the utility "..may charge a fee..to an ESCO, to establish, upon the ESCO's requests, a separate account for one of the commodities the distribution utility provides." NYSEG has modified its tariff to include an Account Separation fee for ESCO-initiated requests to separate an account. The fee covers NYSEG's administrative costs of establishing the second account.

In addition, a revised UBP Addendum is being filed in compliance with Ordering Clause 3 of the Order.

According to Ordering Clause No. 4 of the Order, the requirement of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments has been waived.
