Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or "the Company") is filing today with the Public Service Commission ("the Commission") an amendment to Leaves Nos. 154.1 and 154.2 of its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 9 – Gas ("Gas Tariff"). Specifically, these leaves are issued June 10, 2004 to become effective June 11, 2004, in accordance with ordering clause 2 of the Commission's Order issued and effective June 4, 2004 ("June 2004 Order") in the above referenced proceeding.

Summary of Tariff Changes

On July 23, 2003 and December 30, 2003, the Company filed tariff amendments implementing a new Service Classification Rider to its Gas Tariff, designated as Rider H – Distributed Generation Rate, in compliance with the Commission's Orders issued and effective April 24, 2003 and December 3, 2003 in the above referenced proceeding. These tariff amendments became effective on a temporary basis on January 1, 2004 in accordance with the Commission's December 3, 2003 order.

This filing is being made in compliance with the Commission's June 2004 Order, which directs the Company to file, on not less than one day's notice, further tariff revisions to its Gas Tariff. Specifically, the Company has added a definition for "Distributed Generation" and amended its definition of a "Distributed Generation Facility" to comply with the Order.

Pursuant to ordering clause 3 of the Commission's June 2004 Order, the requirement of Section 66(12) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the amendments is waived.
